SUMMARY OF PROPOSED UNIVERSITY REGULATION AMENDMENT

FSU-4.0335 Suspension and Dismissal of Faculty; Peer Panel.

A peer panel is available for any tenure-track faculty member who has been notified that the member is facing possible suspension or dismissal as a result of disciplinary action. Such a peer panel has been defined as provided in FSU Regulation FSU-4.0335 Suspension and Dismissal of Faculty; Peer Hearing, which is amended here, and is required by Section (6)(b)3. of FSU Regulation FSU-1.004, University Constitution. The Collective Bargaining Agreement between FSU and UFF now provides for a peer panel procedure so this regulation is amended to provide consistency with that Agreement.
