SUMMARY OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO UNIVERSITY REGULATION

6C2R-2.02422. Special Fines, Fees, and Penalties.

This proposed amendment would create an equipment use fee of \$30 per semester for use of computer labs at Oglesby Union, Carothers and Strozier. Also, DROP/ADD transactions in excess of 4 per semester would be charged \$5.00 per excess transaction.

The transcript fee would be increased to \$10.00, the orientation fee increased to \$35.00 and the identification card/Smartcard fee set at \$10 annually, all as authorized by law.

AUTHORITY FOR THE PROPOSED UNIVERSITY REGULATION

The authority for the proposed regulation is as follows: Florida Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedure for State University Boards of Trustees, and Sections 1001.74(1)(a), (3)(c),(6)(b) Florida Statutes.

UNIVERSITY OFFICIALS INITIATING THE REGULATION

The increase in the orientation fee has been initiated by Dr. Mary Coburn, Vice President for Student Affairs; the transcript, computer lab and drop/add fees by Dr. Lawrence G. Abele, Provost and Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs and the Identification /Smartcard fee by John Carnaghi, Senior Vice President for Finance and Administration.
