#### SUMMARY OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO UNIVERSITY REGULATION

6C2R-4.070

Guidelines for Disciplinary Action.

The proposed amendment adds a new disciplinary violation (dd) related to vehicle crashes by university law enforcement personnel. Because of the officers' enhanced responsibility and greater exposure to vehicle crash, a separate category and violation penalty is warranted.
