

FSU Clery Policy - NEW

Purpose of Policy: To ensure the University's compliance with the "Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act," formerly the Crime Awareness and Campus Security Act of 1990, (commonly referred to as the "Clery Act") at all University locations in compliance with 20 U.S.C. §1092 (f).

Reason for policy and what it should accomplish:

- The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (20 USC ss 1092(f)) is the landmark federal law originally known as the Campus Security Act. The Act is a consumer protection law that requires colleges and universities to report campus crime data, support victims of violence, and publicly outline the policies and procedures they have in place to improve campus safety.
 - Clery Act compliance is a campus-wide responsibility for each campus (Main, Panama City, Republic of Panama)
 - Establish University Management's expectations for Clery Act Compliance
 - Designating individuals responsible for coordinating Clery Act compliance
 - Outline compliance expectations and provide guidance
 - Outline reporting requirements
